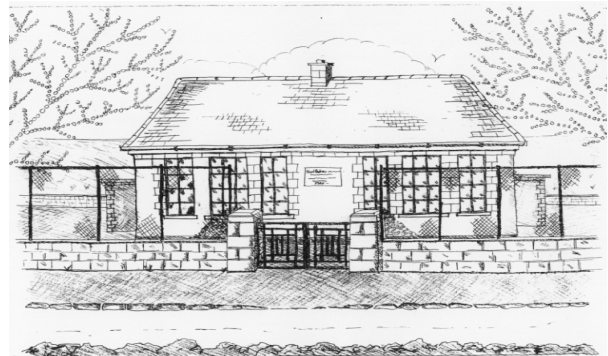

School Uniform Policy

This policy applies to all pupils attending St Patrick's National School. The uniform is a fundamental aspect of the school identity. We expect every pupil to wear the school uniform with dignity and pride and to be aware that, when in uniform, each pupil represents not just themselves but the whole school community. The full uniform is to be worn on NON-PE days or for school events.

The School uniform may consist of:

Crested navy jumper

Navy pinafore or navy skirt.

Navy trousers or plain navy shorts (Summer)(shorts to be knee-length)

Navy/white socks.

Navy/white tights.

Crested polo shirt.

White collared shirt.

Runners or School Shoes

On PE days the navy school tracksuit may be worn

IT IS MANDATORY THAT ALL ITEMS MUST BE CLEARLY LABELLED. SCHOOL WILL CHECK LABELLING.

Jewellery

A simple stud earring is permitted. Dangling / long / looped earrings, bracelets and necklaces are prohibited for health and safety reasons. Make up of any description is not permitted in school. False nails, lashes or fake tan are not permitted.

Hair

Boys and Girls are asked to keep their hair neat and tidy. Long hair must be tied back in the interests of hygiene.

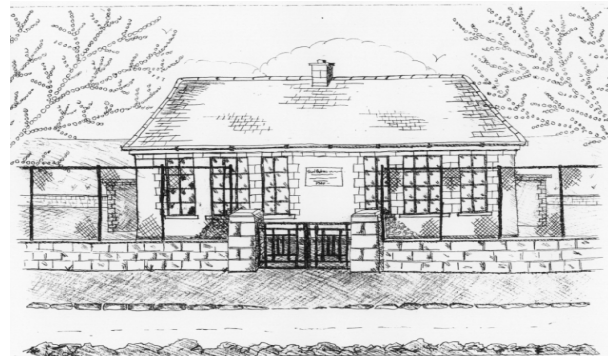

Shoes

Children are required to wear suitable footwear(shoes or runners). Children are not permitted to wear Ugg boots or footwear with a significant heel for health and safety reasons.

- Standardisation of the dress code

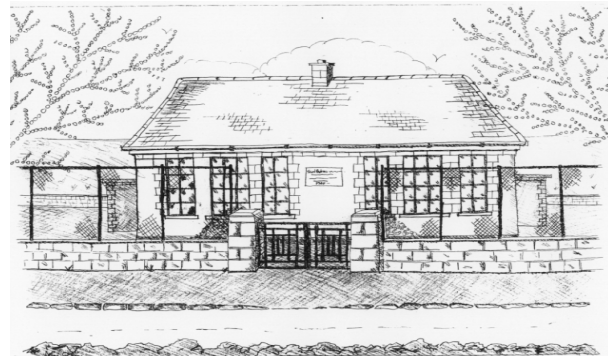
